| <i>Agave shawii</i> | Shaw's Agave | Agave | 1' H x 2' W | Slow | Full to part sun | Drought tolerant | x | A small to medium agave with green ovate leaves and a variable pattern of marginal teeth. Each umbel consists of a mass of yellowish or reddish flowers. |
| <i>Agave shawii</i> ssp. <i>goldmaniana</i> | Shaw's Agave 'Goldmania' | Agave | 2' H x 3' W | Slow | Full sun | Occasional | x | Slow growing and can remain in a large container for several years. |
| <i>Agrostis pallens</i> | Seashore Bent Grass | Grass | 1' H x 1' W | Fast | Part sun to part shade | Moderate | | A drought-tolerant lawn substitute. Tolerates moderate foot traffic and can be mowed. With some supplemental summer water it will remain green year round. |
| <i>Alnus rhombifolia</i> | White Alder | Tree | 60' H x 40' W | Fast | Full to part sun | Moderate/regular | | A very attractive deciduous tree, thriving best in loose soil with a fair amount of moisture. |
| <i>Amorpha fruticosa</i> | Western False Indigo | Shrub | 10' H x 7' W | Fast | Part sun to part shade | Infrequent | | Beautiful foliage and flowers. Interesting, distinctive look. |
| <i>Antigonon leptopus</i> | Coral Vine | Vine | 30' H x 15' W | | Full sun | Drought tolerant | x | Forms underground tubers and large rootstocks. The tubers will re-sprout if it is cut back or damaged by frost. |
| <i>Artemisia californica</i> | California Sagebrush | Shrub | 3-4' H x 4' W | Fast | Full to part sun | Drought tolerant | | Recommended for erosion control. |
| <i>Artemisia douglasiana</i> | Mugwort | Shrub | 4' H x spreading | Fast | Full sun to part shade | Moderate | | Provides good erosion control near streams. |
| <i>Artemisia palmeri</i> | Palmer Sagebrush | Shrub | 3' H x 3' W | Fast | Full to part sun | Moderate | | This plant is rare and threatened by development and flood control projects. |
| <i>Asclepias fascicularis</i> | Narrowleaf Milkweed | Perennial | Flower spikes to 4' H | Fast | Full to part sun | Moderate | | Interesting button flowers. Usually forms small colonies. Adaptable to most conditions. Orioles use dry stems for nesting. |

| <i>Baccharis pilularis</i> ssp. <i>consanguinea</i> | Coyote Brush | Shrub | 4-8' H x 4-8' W | Fast | Full sun | Drought tolerant | | Cut back annually to promote new growth. Very important shrub for wildlife! |
| <i>Baccharis salicifolia</i> | Mule Fat | Shrub | 4-10' H x 8' W | Fast | Full to part sun | Moderate | | Attracts birds and is a forage source for the Dusky Metalmark. High wildlife value. |
| <i>Baccharis salicina</i> | Emory's Baccharis | Shrub | 10' H x 6' W | Fast | Sun or shade | Moderate | | Good for wildlife and habitat gardens. |
| <i>Bouteloua curtipendula</i> | Sideoats Grama | Grass | 2' H x 2' W | Fast | Full sun | Occasional | | Versatile and recommended in semi-dry meadows or grasslands. |
| <i>Bouteloua gracilis</i> | Blue Grama | Grass | 0.5-1' H x 0.5-1' W | Fast | Full to part sun | Occasional | x | Seed heads resemble small flags with an eyelash shape. Recommended for erosion control. |
| <i>Brickellia californica</i> | California Brickellbush | Shrub | 4' H x 3-6' W | Fast | Full sun to part shade | Drought tolerant | | Highly recommended for aromatic gardens. |
| <i>Calystegia macrostegia</i> 'Anacapa Pink' | Anacapa Pink Island Morning Glory | Vine | 20' long | Fast | Full to part sun | Moderate | | Fast growing. Will climb fences, arbors, posts, etc. |
| <i>Carex divulsa</i> | Berkeley Sedge | Grass | 1-1.5' H x 0.5-1' W | Fast | Part shade | Moderate | | A good solution for areas under stress where lawn grasses often fail. The flowers are not particularly noteworthy. |
| <i>Cephalanthus occidentalis</i> | Button Willow | Tree | 8-30' H x 12' W | Fast | Full to part sun | Regular | | Tolerates heat and alkaline soil and thrives in clay. |
| <i>Cercis occidentalis</i> | Western Redbud | Tree | 15' H x 10' W | Fast | Full sun to part shade | Moderate | x | Don't worry about half-circle cuts on the edges of young redbud leaves. Carpenter bees use these soft leaves to build their nests, cutting nickel-sized circles just at the edges of redbud leaves in the spring. |
| <i>Cercocarpus betuloides</i> | Birch-leaf Mountain Mahogany | Shrub | 8-10' H x 8-10' W | Moderate | Full to part sun | Drought tolerant | | Can be kept narrow. Seed plumes shimmer in summer and fall. Wonderful all-purpose plant! |

| <i>Dudleya edulis</i> | San Diego Dudleya | Succulent | 1' H x 1' W | Slow | Full to part sun | Drought tolerant | x | Very drought tolerant in its natural habitat, may need some irrigation outside of its range. |
| <i>Encelia californica</i> | California Bush Sunflower | Shrub | 3' H x 5' W | Fast | Full sun | Drought tolerant | | Without any supplemental water, it will go completely dormant in summer, but an occasional watering will keep it greener. Bloom season can be extended as well with frequent deadheading of spent flowers. |
| <i>Encelia farinosa</i> | Brittlebush | Shrub | 3-5' H x 4' W | Fast | Full sun | Drought tolerant | | The whole bush seems to bloom simultaneously and it's quite common to find plants with several hundred blossoms at one time. |
| <i>Epilobium canum</i> | California Fuchsia | Perennial | 2' H x 4' W | Fast | Full sun | Drought tolerant | x | Goes completely dormant in winter and reemerges in spring. Tough root system provides effective erosion control. |
| <i>Epilobium canum</i> 'Catalina' | Catalina California Fuchsia | Perennial | 3' H x 2' W | Fast | Full sun to part shade | Drought tolerant | x | Grows well on dry, rocky hillsides. |
| <i>Eriogonum fasciculatum</i> | California Buckwheat | Shrub | 3-4' H x 4' W | Fast | Full sun | Drought tolerant | | Flowers emerge in summer and dry to a pretty rust-brown color and persist through the winter and spring. Excellent for erosion control. |
| <i>Eriogonum giganteum</i> | Saint Catherine's Lace | Shrub | 6' H x 6' W | Fast | Full to part sun | Drought tolerant | | Large flowers turn from white to rust as they age. Very ornamental. Cut back after bloom. |
| <i>Eriogonum grande</i> var. <i>rubescens</i> | Red Buckwheat | Perennial | 1' H x 2-3' W | Fast | Full to part sun | Occasional | x | Flowers are rose-colored or red. A good subject for rock gardens. Forms a mat of attractive foliage from which rise many flower stems. |
| <i>Eriophyllum confertiflorum</i> | Golden yarrow | Shrub | 2' H x 1.5' W | Moderate | Full sun | Infrequent | | Beautiful yellow flowers. Very long blooming season. |

| <i>Galvezia juncea</i> 'Punta Banda' | Punta Banda Bush Snapdragon | Perennial | 5' H x 5-6' W | Fast | Full sun | Drought tolerant | | A fast grower that can be pruned into a background hedge or perennial border. The contrast between the tiny green leaves, lime green arching stems and the bright red flowers make this an interesting addition to any native plant garden. |
| <i>Galvezia speciosa</i> | Island Snapdragon | Shrub | 3' H x 5' W | Fast | Part sun to full shade | Drought tolerant | | Good against a north or east-facing wall where it is out of direct sun. |
| <i>Galvezia speciosa</i> 'Firecracker' | Firecracker Island Snapdragon | Shrub | 2-3' H x 3' W | Fast | Part sun to part shade | Drought tolerant | | Tolerates clay, salt, wind. Deep soak occasionally for lush growth. |

| <i>Hesperoyucca whipplei</i> | Chaparral Yucca | Shrub | 4' H x 5' W | Slow | Full sun | Drought tolerant | | The plant takes several (usually 5+) years to reach maturity and flower, at which point it usually dies. Then a cluster of clones around its base continue to grow and reproduce. |
| <i>Heteromeles arbutifolia</i> | Toyon | Shrub | 8-15' H x 10-15' W | Fast | Full to part sun | Drought tolerant | | One of the most beautiful and useful of the native shrubs. Desirable the year round for its handsome foliage: in the spring and early summer for its large clusters of white flowers and in the fall and winter for its attractive red berries. |

| Iris 'Pacific Coast Hybrid' | Pacific Coast Iris | Flower | 2' H x 2' W | Moderate | Full sun to part shade | Occasional | | These tough, evergreen plants produce their delicate flowers in a broad range of colors. |
| Isocoma menziesii | Menzies' Goldenbush | Shrub | 3-4' H x 3-4' W | Moderate | Full to part sun | Occasional | | Leaves are oval-shaped to somewhat rectangular, gray-green and sometimes hairy and glandular, and long with stumpy teeth along the edges. |
| Juncus mexicanus | Mexican Rush | Rush | 2' H x spreading | Fast | Full to part sun | Regular | x | Nice garden color with delicate leaves. Spreads vigorously with wet conditions. |

| Malacothamnus fasciculatus | Chaparral Mallow | Shrub | 3-12' H x 6' W | Fast | Full to part sun | Drought tolerant | | Does well in southern California with little or no water. It has thousands of pink flowers for most of the summer. Good butterfly plant. |
| Maurandya antirrhiniflora | Bluebird Twining Snapdragon | Vine | 10' long | Fast | Full to part sun | Dry/semi-dry | | Perfect for an arbor, pergola, or wrought iron fence. A treat for hummingbirds. |

| Nassella cernua | Nodding Needlegrass | Grass | 2-3' H x 1-2' W | Fast | Full to part sun | Drought tolerant | | Prefers to have good drainage, but is adaptable to heavy soils. Great for erosion control! Loves slopes and difficult areas. |
| Nassella lepida | Foothill Needlegrass | Grass | 1-2' H x 1-2' W | Fast | Full sun to part shade | Drought tolerant | | Does well under native oak trees. Easy to grow and excellent for birds. |
| Nassella pulchra | Purple Needlegrass | Grass | 1-3' H x 2' W | Fast | Full sun to part shade | Drought tolerant | | Recommended for dry, hot areas and clay soils. The official state grass of California. |
| Opuntia littoralis | Coast Prickly Pear | Cactus | 3' H x spreading | Moderate | Full sun | Drought tolerant | x | Fruits are edible. Makes a great barrier! |
| Penstemon centranthifolius | Scarlet Bugler | Perennial | 1-2' H x 1' W | Fast | Full to part sun | Drought tolerant | x | Highly recommended combined with Penstemon spectabilis and Conejo Buckwheat. |
| Penstemon heterophyllus 'Margarita BOP' | Margarita BOP Penstemon | Perennial | 1-2' H x 2-3' W | Fast | Full to part sun | Drought tolerant | x | Adaptable and accepting of heavy soils, some shade and garden care. |
| Penstemon palmeri | Palmer's Penstemon | Perennial herb | 4-5' H x 2' W | | Full sun | Drought tolerant | | One of the few fragrant penstemons. |
| Penstemon spectabilis | Showy Penstemon | Perennial | 4' H x 4' W | Fast | Full sun | Drought tolerant | x | Occasional water lengthens bloom season but may shorten the plant's lifespan. Prune after blooms to promote new growth. |
| Peritoma arborea | Bladderpod | Shrub | 3-4' H x 4' W | Fast | Full to part sun | Drought tolerant | | This gorgeous shrub is native to the Santa Monica Mountains and the Mojave Desert. Flowers light yellow, followed by curiously shaped inflated pods. |
| Prunus ilicifolia | Hollyleaf Cherry | Shrub/tree | 15' H x 15' W | Slow, then fast | Full to part sun | Drought tolerant | | Reliable evergreen landscape plant. Excellent wildlife value. |
| Rhus integrifolia | Lemonadeberry | Shrub | 10' H x 10-30' W | Slow, then fast | Full to part sun | Drought tolerant | | Berries can be made into a tart drink reminiscent of lemonade. |

| <i>Rosa californica</i> | California Wild Rose | Shrub | 5' H x spreading | Moderate | Full sun to part shade | Drought tolerant | | A rather small shrub sending up many branches from the ground soon forming a large clump. Produces many delicate pink fragrant blossoms in late spring and early summer. |
| <i>Rosa woodsii</i> var. <i>ultramontana</i> | Woods' Rose | Shrub | 9' H x spreading | Fast | Full to part sun | Regular | | Very fragrant flowers, great fall color. |
| <i>Salvia apiana</i> | White Sage | Shrub | 3-5' H x 4- 6' W | Fast | Full to part sun | Drought tolerant | | Important Native American ceremonial plant. A local native. Tolerates heavy soil. Bees love it. |
| <i>Salvia brandegei</i> | Brandeggee's Sage | Perennial | 6' H x 6' W | Fast | Full to part sun | Drought tolerant | | A rare sage found only on Santa Rosa Island. Vigorous and easy to grow. Tolerates clay soil. |
| <i>Salvia clevelandii</i> 'Allen Chickering' | Allen Chickering Sage | Shrub | 4-5' H x 4- 5' W | Fast | Full to part sun | Drought tolerant | | Attracts hummingbirds, butterflies, and birds. |
| <i>Salvia clevelandii</i> 'Aromas' | Aromas Cleveland Sage | Shrub | 5' H x 5' W | Fast | Full to part sun | Drought tolerant | | Very drought tolerant salvia with profuse blooms. |

| Salvia 'Skylark' | Skylark Sage | Shrub | 2-3' H x 4-6' W | Fast | Full sun to part shade | Drought tolerant | | Short mounding shrub. Evergreen with some summer water or drought deciduous without. |
| Salvia spathacea | Hummingbird Sage | Perennial | 2' H x spreading | Slow-moderate | Full sun to part shade | Drought tolerant | x | This fruity scented sage blooms March-May with typically dark rose-lilac colored flowers. It is cultivated in gardens for its attractive flowering spikes and pleasant scent. |
| Sisyrinchium bellum | Western Blue-eyed Grass | Perennial | 1-1.5' H x 0.5' W | Fast | Full sun to part shade | Drought tolerant | | Goes dormant in summer, losing some or all of its leaves, and returns with winter rains. |
| Solidago californica | Western Goldenrod | Perennial | 2' H x spreading | Fast | Full to part sun | Drought tolerant | | Blooms in the fall when everything else is done. Spreads from the roots, but slowly. Attracts butterflies. |

| Sporobolus airoides | Alkali Sacaton | Grass | 2' H x 3' W | Fast | Full sun | Drought tolerant | | Graceful seedheads on a robust, tough bunchgrass. Loves clay soil. |
| Stanleya pinnata | Desert Princeplume | Shrub | 3' H x 1.5' W | | Full sun | Drought tolerant | | A conspicuous and beautiful wildflower in the arid west, its flowers generally standing above any nearby shrubs. |
| Thymophylla pentachaeta | Fiveneedle Pricklyleaf | Perennial herb | 1' H x 1' W | Moderate | Full sun | Occasional | | A low, tufted, dark green, prickly plant with 1 small, deep yellow flower head on each of several leafless stalks above foliage. |
| Trichostema lanatum | Woolly Bluecurls | Shrub | 4' H x 4' W | Fast | Full to part sun | Drought tolerant | | Plant in dry, well-drained area. No summer water once established. |
